



TRAVEL GRANTS
for the XVII
INTERNATIONAL NUMISMATIC CONGRESS
IN FRANKFURT, 12–17 September 2027

For the first time, the Pelling Zarnitz Foundation awards two travel grants of € 1.500 (each) for advanced MA students, PhD students and Postdocs to participate in the International Numismatic Congress in Frankfurt (Main), hosted by the Goethe University, in September 2027 (<https://inc2027.org/>, call for papers: September to December 2026).

Applicants must specialise in **Islamic numismatics**, give a presentation in this field at the INC, and attend the entire conference (one week).

Applications in English or German should be submitted as a single PDF file to Dr. Sebastian Hanstein (sebastian.hanstein@uni-tuebingen.de) by **15 August 2026** and include:

- a letter of motivation with the title and a convincing (!) abstract of your intended conference presentation (and, only if applicable, details on further travel plans connected with the INC such as a possible visit to the Research Centre for Islamic Numismatics Tübingen),
- a curriculum vitae (and, only if applicable, a list of publications), accompanied by information on your fields of interest.

The Pelling Zarnitz Foundation encourages applications from the Middle East, North Africa and related regions, and will decide about the travel grants in September 2026.
